aste is considered as items that are obsolete, things that need to be discarded by individuals, households or organisations.

Waste Management in Ondangwa Town

The Council has made provisions for refuse bins to the households and businesses. Each house is provided with either black or green wheeler bin. Waste collected by each household is being picked up the contractors/service provider on a specific day. The Council has outsourced the collection, transportation and disposal of waste to four contractors.

The removal of waste is done once a week at all residential and Business areas on different days.

Gorden Refuse

What is it?

Garden refuse is any kind of refuse that is generated when you have: Leaves, Cut grass, trimmed a tree at your house or in a business.



Who is responsible for this refuse removal?

The Town Council is responsible for removing/collecting any Garden refuse in and around town. There is a program of collecting this type of refuse, whereby council officials go around from different areas to collect any Garden refuse they can find from houses and business areas.

Your Role as a responsible citizen/resident

Once you detect that your garden refuse has not been collected over a week, please inform the council by either calling the Public Health Department at 065-240101 or by visiting the office.

NB: Do not mix your garden refuse with stones, soil or building rubbles.
